<b>Interpostal Seals:</b>	Group of 32	modern Forgeries of red seals: type III of Teh el Barud and type VIIIA of Abou-Chouckouk, Assiout, El-Ayat, Baliana, Bedrechien, Bibeh, Bordein, Bouah, Boulak-Dakrou, Chabas, Chandawil, Cherbine, Deyrouth, Edwa, Facouss, Farchout, Fayoum, Godaba, Gotour, Gouss, Kafr-Amar, Louxor, Mahallet-Abou-Aly, Mallaoui, Manzaleh, Matahne, Mit-Berrah, Port Said, Rodah, Rosetta, Sawakin, and Sidi-Gaber. These were apparently made in the mid-1980s from photographic line cuts of genuine seals and then "issued" without gum. I have backstamped each with the word "FORGERY" with red ink.	10.
